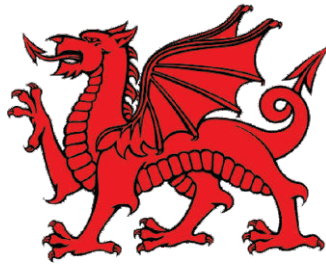

ENTRY FORMS, RULES AND CLOSING DATES.

FORMS

1. All entries must be made on the **CURRENT PRESCRIBED FORM DATED 2023** or a clear photocopy thereof.
2. Entry forms must list only the names of the candidates entered for the category indicated on the form. A separate form must be submitted for each category.

PAYMENTS

3. All payments must be made by EFT. Proof of payment must be submitted along with the entries. Entry fees are not refundable.
4. Cash will be accepted. Please do not make cash deposits as it incurs huge bank charges.
5. If you wish to have your certificates and reports posted to you via Postnet please include R110 in your entry fee and a valid Postnet address. Please email the convener with the proof of payment on tania@buildback.co.za to let her know you have paid for the Postnet delivery and send her the post net address.

NEW SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Please submit a photograph of your work via our new Website. Email the convenor on tania@buildback.co.za and she will create a folder for you and send a link for upload.
2. Each Artwork must be clearly labelled-with name of student, grade, category and school.
3. Please submit a copy of the entry form and detailed list of entries with categories in the same folder as your artwork.
4. Please submit proof of payment into your folder as well.
5. Please email the Convenor (tania@buildback.co.za) the proof of payment, and entry forms (this is for back up).

RULES

6. Candidates **may enter more than once** in the same section.
7. Artwork previously entered may not be submitted again in another year. The art works may not be older than twelve months.
8. The Eisteddfod cannot be held responsible for damage to artworks.
9. Artworks can be shared by candidates and will be accepted as one entry and both will receive a certificate.
10. All works must be original and certified by a teacher or parent.
11. Paintings can be of any size and must be mounted on cardboard or stiff paper. Canvas and boards need not be mounted.
12. If your work is selected for display at the prize giving, please have it available to put up at Wynberg Boys High School on 15 October.
13. The Photography Section is for Amateur Photographers
14. All Artworks and Sculpture items must have a label attached **on the front** stating the class, topic, name of entrant and grade at school. All work **MUST** be labelled with name of student, grade, category and NAME OF SCHOOL and affixed to the front of the work. See example below:

ADJUDICATORS

1. Adjudicators are appointed by the convenor, who shall have the power to terminate the appointment and appoint another adjudicator should serious legitimate complaints be received.
2. No adjudicators may adjudicate the artwork of a close family member or their own pupils.
3. Adjudicators are obliged to give percentages to all Honours and Diploma candidates. These percentages may not be disclosed to entrants but will be known only to the committee for the purpose of making special awards.

PLEASE NOTE: Should any infringement of the rules be detected, it can be reported to the Convenor or Chairperson.

RULES FOR DIGITAL ENTRIES

1. All Digital entries must be accompanied by a flash drive with a time lapse showing regular progress of the creation of the work.
2. Work that does not have a flash drive will not be marked – please ensure flash drive is labelled and able to be read in Windows or Mac.
3. No base images may be used – you must start from a blank canvas.
4. All colours must be created – i.e. you may not use ready-made colours or textures or filters in Photoshop or any other digital software.
5. We reserve the right to reject work that we suspect is not entirely the student's own creation – the onus is on you the student to prove it is your unique work.
6. Only amateur digital artists may enter – if you have received payment for your work – you are not an amateur.
