IMPORTANT DATES FOR YOUR DIARY

- 15 June** : Closing dates for entries for either option
13 - 27 August : Live competition dates
15 October : Prizewinners concert

- Adjudication for live performances will be arranged for a suitable date at your school.
- An additional fee of R500 will be charged for expenses to come to your school, but you are welcome to sell tickets at the door to cover the cost.

GENERAL RULES

1. A choir should have at least 16 members.
2. Choirs should sing two contrasting songs.
Two different **languages** and 2 different **tempos and styles** are required.
3. The time limit is 6 minutes for Primary School Choirs, 8 minutes for High School choirs and 10 minutes for the Open Section. Open Section refers to adult choirs.
4. Backtracks will not be allowed for accompaniment.
5. Instruments other than the piano will be allowed.
6. One copy of the adjudicator's report shall be issued for each entry.
7. Please write the name of the choir, the class and number, and the pieces to be performed as well as the composers, on the entry form.
8. No choir will be allowed to enter more than once in the SAME class.
9. The own choice sections may include a sacred work, but the sacred section must be 2 sacred works.
10. No choir will be allowed to substitute for another.
11. No choir may perform the same work twice even in the following year.
12. Copies of all music must be available for the adjudicator.
13. No teachers may sing with the choirs.

ADJUDICATORS

1. Adjudicators are appointed by the convenor, who shall have the power to terminate the appointment and appoint another adjudicator should serious legitimate complaints be received.
2. No adjudicators may adjudicate the performance of a close family member or their own pupils.
3. Adjudicators are obliged to give percentages to all Honours and Diploma candidates. These percentages may not be read out and will be known only to the committee when choosing special awards.
4. *Should any infringement of the rules be detected, it should be reported to the official on duty or the convenor and NOT the adjudicator. Contravention of this rule could lead to disqualification.*

AWARDS

Cash awards and trophies will only be awarded if a Diploma or High Honours was obtained.

Winners will be awarded with medallions and certificates.
